No organised evening meals: we're leaving entrants freedom to book themselves any meal they wish. This is because the Min-y-Mor hotel is not formally involved this year. Of course, we still imagine that some entrants may book accommodation there and, individually or in groups, book themselves meals there, with it having a large capacity. There are other restaurants and takeaways in town, also.

This will be a **six-round** McMahon tournament, with Fischer timing of 30 minutes main time, plus 10 seconds per move bonus. BGA rules apply. Komi is 7 points.

Single-day players are also most welcome. Any players wishing to miss certain rounds are welcome to do so.

Prizes will be awarded to those on 4.5 wins or above (extra prizes at organisers' discretion).

Entry Fees

£20: Standard entry fee for BGA members or members of a national Go association.

£26: Non-BGA member's entry fee.

£13: BGA member concession entry fee – as follows:

Concessionary rates apply to UK residents who are: under 18 on 31st August 2023, or under 26 and studying full-time at an approved educational establishment in the UK, or receiving an unemployment, disability or Pension Credit benefit.

All the above are halved for people playing on only one of the days.

£3: Additional late entry fee (entries received after Tuesday 20th June).

Pay on the day at registration (cash only). Fees include free coffee, tea and biscuits.
