EUROPEAN GO CONGRESS IN NANUR: (EGP)

My provisional information is that about 20 Britons attended the Congress which saw 224 competitors.

The main event was won by S. Zhang (6d, China) with 9/10.

Second was A. Lazarev (6d SU) and third was J. Guo (6d China).

Richard Hunter (3d) had the best British result with 7/10.

The weekend tournament was won by Shutai Zhang, second was Juan Guo and third was Laurent Heiser.

Mark Hall and Matthew Cocke both won 4/5.

FUJITSU EUROPEAN GRAND PRIX:

The European Congress marked the culmination of the 16 rounds of this year's competition:
